Organize TIP:

Organize a great landing area for the kids school supplies.

Developing a great landing area for the kid's school supplies can be vital in helping your kids to have a successful school year.

First, designate an area that is close to the door where the child enters when returning home from school.

Second, place a bench, baskets, a cabinet, or even hooks on the wall, in this designated area that can store your child's backpack and school supplies.

Third, have an "IN" and an "OUT" area for paperwork and/or homework. Does your child need paperwork reviewed or homework completed daily? Label this area with your kids names while using variety of colors to make it exciting.

Fourth, work with your child so that they understand that this landing area is for them and their success at school. Be patient; it may take a few days or weeks for the child to get the understanding of this great system you have set up for them.
